## Notes from the School Nurse

Welcome back!!! I hope you have had a wonderful summer. As you look ahead to the coming months, I wanted to make you aware of a few things that are on the calendar. With the help of our wonderful PTA parent volunteers we provided a vision screening for all students grade 1-6 on Monday morning, September 26th. If your child did not pass the vision screening, I will contact you regarding the need for a professional eye exam. If you need financial assistance to get glasses, please contact me and I can provide help.

Flu season is approaching, and you can be protected from the seasonal flu by being vaccinated. The Weber Morgan Health Department nurses will provide a flu shot clinic at Kanessville on Tuesday, October 25th at 1:30 pm. The flu shot is available to all staff, students, and community members. Watch for permission slips to come home in the next few weeks. For those students in 6th grade who need their required vaccines for 7th grade, they will have the opportunity to receive their Tdap booster, Meningitis, vaccine, and a 2nd Chickenpox vaccine if they have only had one. These 3 vaccines are required for 7th grade entry.

Just a reminder that if your child needs medication at school, they cannot carry it with them. We are happy to keep medication at school for them, but you must have your doctor fill out an authorization form allowing it to be given at school. This form must also be signed by you. This applies to all prescriptions and over the counter medications, including herbal remedies, essential oils, etc. This policy protects your child and all children that attend Kanessville Elementary.

I hope you have a wonderful year. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns. I am at the school on Tuesdays, but can be reached by email anytime.
