Notes from the School Nurse

Breakfast-Still Kid's Most Important Meal of the Day

Breakfast is still the most important meal of the day. It fuels your child with enough energy to learn and play. Encouraging good breakfast eating habits early in life provides good nutrition for the short haul and good eating habits for a lifetime.

Studies show that students who eat breakfast:

- Learn better
- Are more alert and attentive
- Are more likely to participate in activities



Plan ahead to have foods on hand so you don't skip breakfast. Try to include foods from at least 3 food groups for breakfast. A balance breakfast could include cereal, bagels or bread, a serving of fruit, such as bananas or peaches, and low-fat milk. You have a quick and nutritiously balanced breakfast to start your child's day off in the right direction. A healthy and balanced diet in childhood can reduce the risk of anemia and dental decay.
