Principal's News

2016, here we go! We are coming to the end of the first semester, and things are moving along very well at Kanessville. It's cold outside so please send your children to school adequately dressed to be outside in the elements for 20 minutes at a time. Exercise and fresh air are very important to our children's ability to learn in the classroom, so we will be having them go outside for recesses unless conditions are too extreme.

As you plan for the rest of the year, please make every effort to avoid making plans that require your children to miss school. The year is half over, and we have a lot to cover before the end of the year. Parent Teacher Conferences will be on February 3rd and 4th so please plan now to be available to attend. We have a longer testing window this year that begins with our SAGE writing test window that starts on March 28th. All students in grades 3-6 will be taking tests in March; and then again starting in mid-April and going to the end of the year.

Please remember our parking lot procedures and be willing to follow them. Please wait patiently in the line and load your child at the curb. Please do not stop at the corner and call you child to you. When a spot opens in front of you, please move forward and pick up your child as close to the front doors a possible. This will keep the line moving and make it better for everyone. Students are not allowed to leave the curb unless they are being escorted to a parked car by a parent. If you call to your child to come to you, our staff is instructed to keep them at the curb until you come and physically escort them to your car. Thank you for working with us to make sure that all of our students are safe, and to expedite the process for everyone.

All Kids Deserve a Winning Smile!

Why does dental care matter?

- About 1 in 5 kids has an untreated cavity.
- Tooth decay can be prevented.
- A winning smile increases self-esteem.
- Dental problems cause kids to miss school.
- Good oral health improves nutrition.

What can you do?

Help families understand it is important to:

- Have their child's first dental visit by age one and at least twice a year after that.
- Get fluoride varnish as part of a well-child visit with their doctor.
- Get dental sealants on permanent molar teeth.
- Clean their child's teeth.

Children enrolled in CHIP or Medicaid can get:

- Regular dental check-ups
- Regular dental cleanings
- Fluoride treatments
- Dental sealants
- Dental treatments, as needed
